The LCSB, a community of Lay Benedictines, which celebrated its 50th anniversary in 2021 (www.lcsb.uk), wishes to recruit a Christian, who will be part of the community in a vocational and developmental role. The Discipleship and Digital Coordinator will be welcomed and formed in our Benedictine charism, through mentoring and personal accompaniment. The role offers the possibility of developing digital and organisational skills, being part of a praying Benedictine community, which is ecumenical, and growing the confidence to lead others, young and old.

The job duties will include building digital communications/resources, participating in large whole community events (over Easter and at the Summer Gathering/AGM of the Community in August) and in regional meetings, as well as building a support network of prayer and relationship for young adults aged 18-35, and working with Teens team leaders to create a support/prayer network for teenagers.

The successful applicant must have excellent communication skills and experience of liaising with a variety of groups, working with young people, as well as good influencing skills. Being a resilient self-starter with initiative is essential. Building digital communication media such as podcasts and blogs, and musical ability in leading worship would be a plus. Knowledge of the LCSB and its ethos and/or the Benedictine charism together with experience of using social media is preferred but not essential as training will be given.
